Directions to Origin from the Lexington Bluegrass Airport (LEX)

1. Head SE on Terminal Dr. (.3mi)
2. Continue straight on Terminal Dr. (.1mi)
3. Turn right onto Man-O-War Blvd (6.3mi)
4. Use 2nd to left land to turn left onto Nicholasville Rd (.1mi)
5. Turn right at first light onto Larue (.2m)
6. Turn Right onto Summit at Fritz Farm (486ft)
7. Turn left to stay on Summit at Fritz Farm (69ft)
8. Continue straight to Rowan, Origin will be on your left (89ft)

Directions from Origin to Kentucky Equine Adoption Center

1. Head east on Rowan (128ft)
2. Rowan turns slightly left and becomes Pendleton (436 ft)
3. Turn left on Larue (259ft)
4. Turn left onto Summit at Fritz Farm (486ft)
5. Turn right toward Man-O-War Blvd (.1m)
6. Turn left onto US 27/ Nicholasville Rd (3.4)
7. Turn Right onto Hwy 3375/Catnip Hill Rd
8. Travel 8/10 of a mile, KyEAC will be on your right

Directions from Comfort Suites to Kentucky Equine Adoption Center

1. Head northwest on Fieldstone Way (230ft)
2. Turn right on Fieldstone Way (.1m)
3. Turn right onto Beaumont Centre Pkwy (459ft)
4. Turn right onto US-68/Harrodsburg Rd (5.6mi)
5. Turn left onto Hwy 3375/Catnip Hill Rd (1.5 mi)
6. KyEAC will be on your right.

Area Attractions

There are plenty of shopping and restaurants around both hotels.

Shaker Village-Harrodsburg- Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill is a landmark destination that shares 3,000 acres of discovery in the spirit of the Kentucky Shakers. With 34 original Shaker structures, the site is home to the country's largest private collection of original 19th century buildings and is the largest National Historic Landmark in Kentucky.

Kentucky Horse Park-Lexington- Kentucky's own Horse "Theme" Park, with shows, a museum, and great restaurant.

UK Arboretum-Lexington- The Arboretum, State Botanical Garden of Kentucky is a 100-acre greenspace located on the campus of the University of Kentucky in the heart of Lexington.

Historic Midway, KY- Visit this quaint little historic town that has a little for everyone, scenic drive of rolling horse farms, historic downtown with shops, and restaurants.

The Bourbon Trail- Awaken your senses and explore the birthplace of Bourbon as you embark on a self-guided journey to discover the story inside every bottle on The Kentucky Bourbon Trail® and the Kentucky Bourbon Trail Craft Tour®.

Visit Horse Country- Horse Country Inc., is the tour operator that is partnered with the KyEAC in bringing tourists to the center, they are an organization of horse farms, equine medical clinics and equine attractions dedicated to sharing the stories of Kentucky's Horse Country.
