1. Head north from terminal. 0.4 miles
2. Take the 1st right onto East Plumb Lane (signs for Plumb Lane/  
U.S. 395 S/Carson City/Lake Tahoe) 0.2 miles
3. Turn left onto the U.S. 395 S/Interstate 580 S ramp to Carson City 4.8 miles
4. Exit S. Meadows Pkwy (Take exit 60) 0.3 miles
6. Turn left onto S Meadows Parkway 0.5 miles
7. Turn right onto Double R Blvd 0.4 miles
8. Turn right onto Professional Circle 0.4 miles
9. Turn left to stay on Professional Circle 0.09 miles

4. Take the US-395 S exit, EXIT 57B, toward Virginia City / Carson City / So Lake Tahoe.

5. Merge onto US-395 Alt S / S Virginia St. 0.5 miles
6. Turn left onto Geiger Grade Rd / NV-341. 0.2 miles
7. Enter next roundabout and take the 1st exit onto NV-341. 13.2 miles
8. Turn left onto Union St. 0.07 miles
9. Take the 2nd right onto E St. 0.04 miles

2. Take the 1st left to stay on Professional Cir. 0.1 mile
3. Take the 1st right onto Double R Blvd. 0.3 miles
4. Take the 1st right onto Damonte Ranch Pkwy. 0.6 miles
5. Turn left onto S Virginia St / US-395 Alt S. 3.1 miles
6. Turn left onto Rhodes Rd (Portions unpaved). 0.9 miles
7. Take the 2nd left onto Chance Ln (Portions unpaved). 0.3 miles

1. Start out going north on E St toward Union St. 0.04 miles
2. Take the 1st left onto Union St. 0.07 miles

4. Enter next roundabout and take the 3rd exit onto Geiger Grade Rd / NV-341.  
0.3 miles
5. Turn left onto S Virginia St / US-395 Alt S. 1.9 miles
6. Turn left onto Rhodes Rd (Portions unpaved). 0.9 miles
7. Take the 2nd left onto Chance Ln (Portions unpaved). 0.3 miles
