 2. Turn left onto Pine Ridge Ln 131 ft
 3. Pine Ridge turns slightly right and becomes Aero Dr. 0.4 mi
 4. Continue onto Nederland Ave 427 ft
 5. Turn left onto Hwy 69N/Memorial/US 69 Access Rd 0.2 mi
 6. Use the left lane to take the ramp onto US-287 N/US-69 N/US-96 N 0.1 mi
 7. Follow US-287 N/US-69 N/US-96 N to Interstate 10 Access Rd in Beaumont. Exit from US-287 N/US-69 N/US-96 N 11.5 mi
 8. Merge onto Interstate 10 Access Rd.
